



Vacancy Announcement

CARE Nepal is an international humanitarian organization working in the country for the past 39 years. It currently works in 60 districts through various programs on issues relating to improving the lives of the poorest and most vulnerable populations through programs that work on the following themes: food security and climate change; emergency preparedness and DRR; migration and urbanization; sexual reproductive and maternal health; gender based violence; women and girls' leadership. Marginalized Women and Adolescent Girls are our two primary impact groups. Core priorities include investment in the empowerment and leadership of women and girls, reaching hard to reach population, good governance and accountability, working in partnership and alliance with like-minded actors, and evidence-based advocacy.

1. Program Specialist – Family Planning and Post Abortion Care (based in Gorkha)

Key responsibilities:

The incumbent is responsible to work in close coordination with Emergency Response Manager in the district and, SRH Specialist and Program Coordinator – SRMH and GBV in CARE Nepal Central Office to implement CARE Nepal's Emergency Recovery Program in Sexual Reproductive Maternal Health (SRMH) at Gorkha district. S/he will primarily be responsible for implementing the Family Planning and Post Abortion Care (SAF-PAC) Program. S/he will provide technical support at district for program implementation, coordination and liaison, advocacy and communication, monitoring and supervision to ensure quality of the program activities under the project.

Preferred Qualifications and Experience:

Masters Degree in Nursing or Public Health with clinical background and at least 3 years of relevant experience in Family Planning and Safe Abortion Program.

2. Food Security and Livelihoods Officer (based in Kathmandu)

Key responsibilities:

The Food Security and Livelihood Officer will be responsible to assist in data base management, implementation of project activities, M&E plan, procurement process and documentation of CARE Nepal supported EQ Food Security, Livelihood and Cash program.

Preferred Qualifications and Experience:

Bachelor's degree in Agriculture Science from a recognized university with good knowledge of analysing seasonal and off season vegetable production and marketing, cooperative capacity building, database management, with enough value chain knowledge on fresh vegetable production and livestock. The incumbent requires to have a minimum of 3 years of relevant experience.
