



***Internship – Maternal, Neonatal and Reproductive Health***

**Introduction**

CARE Nepal is an international humanitarian organization working in Nepal for the past 39 years. It currently works in 60 districts through different projects and programs on issues relating to improving the lives of the poorest and most vulnerable populations through programs in natural resource management, livelihoods, women empowerment, equity and social justice.

Strengthening Approach of Maximizing for Maternal, Neonatal and Reproductive Health (SAMMAN) is a health project of CARE Nepal being implemented in five districts i.e. Doti, Dadeldhura, Kailali, Kavre and Sindhuli District. The aim of the project is to increase access to Maternal Neonatal and Child Health (MNCH) services through a balanced approach of demand generation with the capacity building of community through strengthening the health system on MNCH.

CARE Nepal hereby invites interested candidate for internship in SAMMAN project. The intern will be responsible for providing support to the project team and partner organizations in facilitating community initiative processes, capacity development of frontline health workers, health volunteers, local leaders and field staffs. S/he will collect & document relevant case stories, process document for the dissemination of project's effectiveness. S/he is expected to work in close coordination and maintain good working relationship with frontline health workers and partner organizations in the district for the smooth operation of project activities.

**The intern will assist the project with the following activities:**

- Support in the process of behavior mapping and implementing partner in the implementation of the community mobilization activities of the Project at community.
- Identify related IEC/BCC materials and facilitate to use them in community for awareness
- Support partner agency to identify and engage men, women and children in the community to improve the health seeking behaviors of mothers
- Facilitate partner agency to strengthen capacity of mothers' group for health and link them with other self help groups and organization for empowerment and behavior change
- Work with implementing partner, community groups, local health facility to establish community health score board (CHSB) at health facility to improve social accountability in health
- Support implementing partner in building partnerships with the municipality, and local cooperative organization for resource mobilization on MNCH activities CARE Nepal
- Provide Support to the Monitoring and Evaluation Specialist and Maternal Neonatal Health Officer in documentation of the project interventions
- Conduct regular field visits as needed
